ZUBRI PROPANE PATIO HEATER INSTRUCTIONS

To assemble the heater:

- Remove all the pieces from the carrying case.
- Attach the legs first, depress the spring button on the leg and slide the leg into the leg holder on the body of the heater. Make sure the button locks into place.
- Wrap the black skirt around the legs and Velcro at the top. Zip up the side and adjust the skirt so that the zipper runs along one leg.
- Remove the top from the case. Slide it over the central post on the top of the heater and unfold the wing nut. Tighten until secure.
- Lift the propane cylinder onto the hook underneath the heater. The propane tank supplies additional weight to the heater to make it more stable.
- Fix the gas regulator to the cylinder. Make sure it is securely fitted.

To light the heater:

- Turn on the valve of the propane tank.
- Hold a flame under the burned head of the heater.
- Push in the control knob and turn counter-clockwise all the way. Keep the control knob pushed in for at least 15 seconds after the heater has lit.
- If the flame goes out, turn off the propane valve, wait two minutes and repeat the steps.
- To adjust the heat, push the control knob in and turn counter-clockwise to increase and clockwise to decrease.

To turn off the heater:

- Push the control knob in and turn all the way clockwise to shut off the heater.
- Turn off the propane valve and allow the heater to cool before moving or storing.
